

# CA Working to Institutionalize Sex Ed (CA-WISE) 2017-2018 Comprehensive Sex Ed Networks

Cardea coordinated 16 Comprehensive Sexual Education Network (CSEN) meetings with district administrators and other stakeholders to help them adopt, deliver and sustain high quality sex education and supportive policies that align with the California Healthy Youth Act (CHYA).

## General Overview

**345** participants from 60 unique CA districts attended CSEN meetings

**44** community partners joined the meetings to provide resources and support\*

\*Example community partners include: ACLU, CA Department of Public Health, Diversity Center, Health Connected, LACOE, Office of LGBTQ Affairs, Planned Parenthood, Rape Trauma Services, Salud Para La Gente, and YWCA.

## CSE-N participating counties



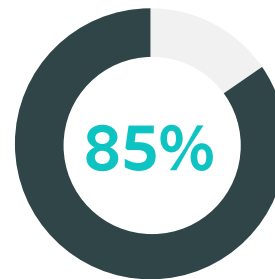
## End of Year Survey Results

Districts reported that CSEN meeting topics were **extremely useful**:

- Teacher training and on-going support **4.9**
- Linking students with health services **4.9**
- Special education and alternative education **4.8**
- Building community support for CSE **4.7**
- Sexual orientation and gender identity **4.7**
- Tips for evaluation and soliciting input from stakeholders **4.7**
- Alternatives for students who opt out **4.4**
- Trauma-Informed CSE **4.4**
