2017-2018 Santa Clara and San Mateo

Cardea coordinated Comprehensive Sexuality Education Network (CSEN) meetings for district administrators and other stakeholders through the Santa Clara and San Mateo County Offices of Education. These meetings supported adoption, delivery and sustainability of high quality sex education and supportive policies that align with the California Healthy Youth Act (CHYA).

General Overview

116 participants from 22 unique districts attended CSEN meetings

15 community partners joined the meetings to provide resources and support*

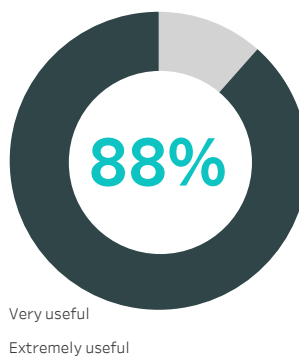
End of Year Survey Results

Respondents reported that CSEN meeting topics were **extremely useful**:

- Teacher training and on-going support **4.9**
- Linking students with health services **4.9**
- Special education and alternative education **4.8**
- Building community support for CSE **4.7**
- Sexual orientation and gender identity **4.7**
- Tips for evaluation and soliciting input from stakeholders **4.7**
- Alternatives for students who opt out **4.4**
- Trauma-Informed CSE **4.4**

Average scores based on a range of 1 (not useful) to 5 (extremely useful)
